Learn the beautiful art of theorem painting in the *Theorem Painting Workshop* scheduled for Saturday, December 12, 2009 from 9 am to 3 pm. Noted theorem artist Sandra Coldren will teach participants the painting techniques for the 19th century form of stenciling known as theorem painting and how to paint the theorem design "Gift Basket of Fruit".



All skill levels will enjoy using pre-cut stencils and artist oil paints on cotton velveteen, while learning the history of this traditional American art in this workshop. Each participant will complete one theorem design on cotton velveteen suitable for framing in a standard 11" x 14" frame. (frame not included) and receive one set of stencils and written instructions to create theorems of the same design at home. The instructor will also bring along the extra supplies for sale to any participant wishing to paint additional theorems.
