1865	Henry S. Bower - Jacob M. Moyer - Horace F. Shisler Seeds -Harleysville, Lower Safford Twp., 1865-1957 & Papers April 12, deed from John G. and Sarah Swartley to Henry L. Bower, who paid \$5300 for 39 acres which John and Rachel Delp had sold to John Swartley on April 6, 1857.
1871	Feb. 1, Adam Baker sells 38 perches of land to Drs.Reinhard Keeler and Henry G. Groff.
1872	April 3, Dr. Reinhard Keeler sells a lot of eighty perches of land to Henry S. Bower (next to Henry Bower's lane)
1873	June 12 – Henry Bower buys 80 perches of land from Drs. Keeler and Groff.
1874	May 5 – Henry S. Bower sells 153 perches of land (from what Henry had purchased from the Swartleys) to Adam Baker for \$237.
1889	May 2 – Henry M. Clemmer signs a demand note of \$1400 to his wife Mary, "without interest." Pencilled note: "afer my Death this note is void."
<b>(</b> 1900	January 1, John S. Nice sold the bakery property to Abraham K. Moyer.)
1909	April 7, Abraham K. Moyer and wife Kate, for \$6000 sell the bakery property to Jacob M. Moyer. [Noted added: "Former deed lost."
1916	May 1, Jacob and Flora Moyer convey the bakery with one acre and 21 perches of land to Joseph and Esther Weber for \$7500.
1918	January 10 – "Joseph H. Weber was duly adjudicated a voluntary bankrupt." On January 16 Alvin Alderfer was appointed temporary receiver to sell said bakery business
1918	January 19 – Jacob M. Moyer, a judgment creditor of said bankrupt" offered "at private sale, the sum of \$4 21.39 for all the real and personal assets of said bankrupt."
1918	Mar. 4 – Jacob Moyer buys the bakery again.
1920	Mar. 21 Mortgage from Henry M. Clemmer to son-in-law Horace F. Shisler, for \$5800, for transfer of the Clemmer farm to Horace.

June 20 – Bond signed by Jacob M. Moyer to widow Sarah Nyce for \$2500, to be paid by the end of the year. A pencilled note on the back reads, "Interest paid to June 1923. Interest paid in full and mortgage paid off."

June 21 – Mortgage from widow Sarah Nyce to Jacob M. Moyer, for \$2500, for a bakery in Harleysville.

- Mar. 27 Jacob M. Moyer takes out a mortgage of \$2,000 from the Harleysville Building and Loan Association.
- 1921 September 26 -- Jacob and Flora Moyer convey the bakery property to Horace and Maggie Shisler for one dollar, but subject to the \$2500 mortgage that Jacob had to Widow Sarah M. Nyce, and another mortgage of \$2000 to the Harleysville Building and Loan Association. [Note: at one point J. M. Moyer made a quick loan of \$500 from his cousin, Abraham M. Landis, and later paid it back.]

(Horace Shisler sold the former Clemmer farm to Herb Knechel.)

Sept. 1 – Henry M. Clemmer makes his will. Witnessed by son-in-law Horace Shisler and neighbor Abraham A. Price.

(Nov. 23 – Henry M. Clemmer died)

Dec. 4 - Henry M. Clemmer's will is proved.

May 25, Horace and Maggie Shisler to Horace and Maggie Shisler, \$1 for the old bakery property (their home).
