The Salome Bergey Letter Collection was purchased by John L. Ruth for the Mennonite Historians of Eastern Pennsylvania in August of 1985. The collection consists of 80 letters and poems written to and by Salome Bergey, of the Doylestown Mennonite Congregation.

Salome Bergey was the daughter of Abraham Wismer Bergey (1815-1888) and Anna Kile Bergey (1817-1860) of the Doylestown Mennonite Congregation. Her grandparents were Jacob Bergey (1784-1865) and Esther Wismer Bergey (1797-1877), who were also members of the Doylestown Mennonite Congregation. Strangely, her name is not recorded in the Bergey Family History, but her own letters prove that she was a daughter of Abraham and Anna. She mentions almost all of her brothers and sisters in her various letters, and the Bergey Family History does record them as being children of Abraham and Anna Bergey.

Another mysterious fact about Salome Bergey is that she is not buried in the Doylestown Mennonite cemetery, where the rest of her family is buried. She lived near Doylestown and was obviously a member of the Mennonite congregation there. Neither is she buried in any of the other central Bucks County Mennonite cemeteries.

Salome wrote and received many letters to and from the Bishop Abraham Wismer family of Skippack, Montgomery County. Abraham Wismer (1797-1877) was married to Susanna Kolb and was ordained a minister in 1838, and a bishop in 1852, in the Skippack Mennonite congregation. Abraham was a cousin to Salome's grandmother, Esther Wismer Bergey. Abraham's daughter Susan married John Wismer Bergey (1823-1893), a son of Jacob and Esther Wismer Bergey, and an uncle of Salome Bergey (in other words, John and Susan Wismer Bergey were second cousins). Abraham Wismer, Jr.(b. 1834) and his wife, Franey Landes Wismer, also exchanged many letters with Salome Bergey. According to these letters, Salome visited in Skippack with her uncle John Bergey. She records fond memories of those visits in her letters.

Salome's letters indicate that she was paralyzed in one of her limbs, and that she was never married. Inventory and index follows.
