Box 6, Scrapbook 3: *John and Edith Lapp, Congregational Memories, 1933-1973* (contains 141 photos)

This scrapbook was compiled by members of Plains Mennonite Church and given to John and Edith Lapp at a celebration of John's forty years in ministry, August 1, 1973 (see also photo file 9-3). Photos are listed as they appear in the album, generally top to bottom and left to right.
