Inventory

Photos are inventoried at the item level, and each photo or photo group has a three-part number (e.g. 39-2-6 means Box 39, file 2, photo or photo group #6). Two-part numbers refer to files, three-part numbers refer to individual photos or photo groups.

As is the case throughout the I. C. Kulp Collection, the designation “DVD 0.00:00” represents a location of discussion on the DVDs recorded by Gene Wampler, 2001. The notation is read as DVD#.minutes:seconds (e.g. DVD 25.27:30 means discussion is on DVD #25, beginning at 27 minutes and 30 seconds). This also allows location of relevant discussion in the typed DVD transcription.
